

LOCAL VARIETAL POMEGRANATES


It's Fall. Time for Pomegranates, Pumpkins, and Persimmons. We will discuss the latter two in the next few weeks as this week we are offering four distinct varieties of pomegranates from **Windmill Vineyards**, a farm and event center located nearby in **Woodland**, **CA**. The most common variety, the industry standard, is the large glossy crimson red pomegranate with the varietal name **Wonderful**. While the Wonderful variety is probably the best



looking pomegranate, it is the ruby red kernels, each containing a hard seed, botanically called Arils, that are more important than the external leathery skin. The seeds of the four varieties we are offering

this week differ in color, flavor, and texture. **Sharp Velvet**-A large sized pomegranate with a dark red

exterior and dark seeds the color of crushed red velvet. The seeds are tender and crisp with a burst of sweet juice and mild acid. **Pink Satin**-Tender translucent pink seeds with refreshing sweet flavor.

MARKET MOVERS



Avocado-Transition to Mexican fruit has been a little bumpy. Fruit-oil content-has been inconsistent. Boxes have been a little "checker board" or unevenly ripened. This weeks fruit seems to be more consistent. The market is down slightly. **Berries**-The Strawberry market is easing in to the mid 20's. Last weeks rain

caused harvesting and quality issues with northern fruit. Southern fruit slightly higher. Stemberries limited-and smaller. Raspberry market in mid 30's. Blackberries-mid 30's, Blueberries up drasti-

cally-mid 40's. Fresh Cranberries will start early next week. *Citrus*-Lemon market should begin to ease next week. Pipeline is refilling as new regions begin to harvest. Grapefruit will be very limited for another 2 weeks, the market is in high 30's. Lime market is rea-



sonable in mid high teens. *Grapes*-Red and Green market in high 20's. Cotton Candy, Concord, Witch Finger and Champagne Grapes are done for the season. *Melons*-Cantaloupe and Honeydew are finishing in Northern and Central California. All mixed Melons and specialty varieties are done for the season. Vierra Farms will have Black Seedless Watermelons for another week or so. *Pears*-



Stillwater Seckels and French Butter have already finished for the season. Next week we will transition to Northwest (Oregon) fruit. **Stonefruit**-All local stonefruit is done for the season. **Tropical** Pineapple market has eased into high teens. Fruit has very good

flavor and color. Mango supplies are very limited. Currently sourcing fruit from Brazil. Starfruit (Taiwan) has returned. Available by the case or piece. *Asparagus*-Quality and shelf life were affected by hurricane and heavy rainfall in Mexico. Product seems to be improving this week. *Beans*-Dwelley Beans are winding down. All varieties still available. *Broccoli*-Market steady on Bunched-mid 20's, Crowns-high 20's. *Brussels Sprouts*-Monterey coastal growers are fighting overcast skies which is slowing growth. Quality re-

mains very good, market in high 30's. *Cabbage*-Northern growers are finishing. Very little Cabbage grown in southern region due to water restrictions. Market in high 20's on Green and it could be several weeks before we see relief. *Corn*-Brentwood and Dix-



on will harvest this week; market remains very strong low 30's. *Cauliflower*-Supplies continue to be limited-high 20's. *Cucumbers*-California slicers and English Cukes are finishing Mexican market slightly higher. *Lettuces*-Iceberg easing into high teens. Butter, Romaine, and Romaine Hearts slightly higher. *Peppers*-Castaneda struggling to meet demand. Cooler temps slowing growth-size. Sourcing Bells and Chiles from Southern California and Mexican growers. *Squash*-Italian and Yellow Squash are up drastically as Northern California growers finish. Market in high 20's. Summer and Sunburst very limited. Local Butternut, Acorn, Delicata, Kabocha, Red Kuri, & Spaghetti available. We are offering



assorted pumpkins. *Tomatoes*-Round market very steady-high teens. Roma improving-mid 20's. *Wild Mushrooms*-Chanterelles from Oregon are limited (heavy rain). The market is slightly higher-high teens. "*Farm to you overnight"*
