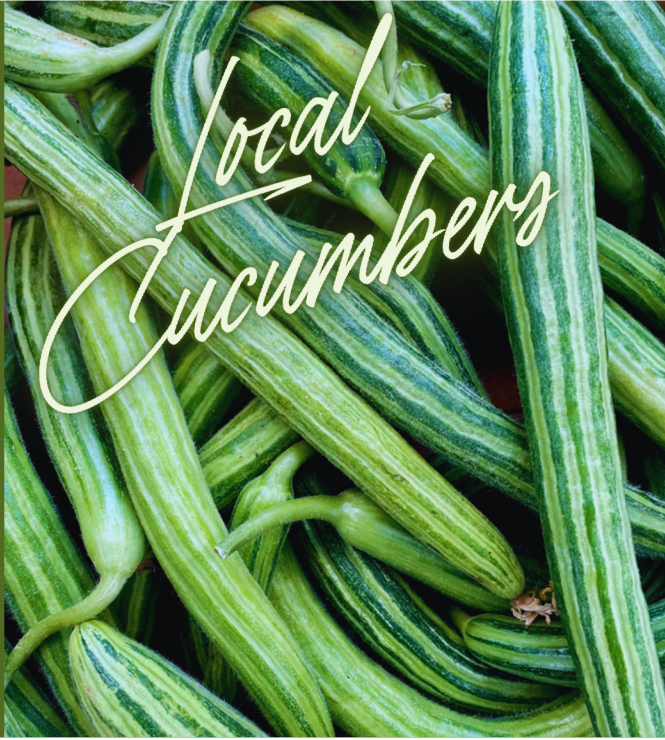




Market Outlook



LOCAL FEATURE

Armenian Cucumbers- Long, slender, and light green cucumber. It is known for its mild and sweet flavor and thin skin. Unlike other varieties, the skin is not bitter, regardless of maturity. *10# case, item #12020*

Painted Serpent Cucumbers- Similar to the Armenian cucumber, Painted Serpents are long and twisted with deep ridges. Crisp, mild, and nearly seedless. *10# case, item #12050*

Lemon Cucumbers- An heirloom variety with a round shape and thin yellow skin. It is named the lemon cucumber due to its appearance, not its flavor profile. *10# case, item #12035*
